There are three categories of bequests to the School:

- a bequest for general purposes, where the School will decide which projects are to be funded by the bequest, being the projects at the School with the greatest priority at the time of the donor's death
- a bequest for a stated purpose, where the donor specifies the particular initiative to benefit, such as a particular faculty or department or a particular area of interest
- a bequest to fund student awards (scholarships, prizes and bursaries). You may wish to support students in difficult financial circumstances.
